

ACES SCHOLARSHIP

Requirements for the ACES Scholarship are as follows:

Request for the ACES Scholarship shall be made upon the prescribed "[ACES Scholarship Application](#)" which must be completed in full.

The applicant, at the time of his/her request, shall be employed either full-time or part-time (in a non managerial position) in an Assessor's Office in the State of Connecticut.

The educational program for which the ACES Scholarship is requested shall pertain to the assessment profession (e.g., CCMA courses, ACES modules, IAAO courses or one-day seminars, appraisal courses, etc.)

The amount of the ACES Scholarship granted shall be for the program fee only and shall not exceed \$1000 per application.

The scholarship will be awarded upon the successful completion of the program for which the applicant is applying.

The applicant shall provide a letter, signed by the Finance Director or Chief Executive Officer of his/her municipality, stating that the municipality will not pay for, nor reimburse the applicant, for the full cost of the course for which the scholarship is requested.

The decision to grant or deny the scholarship, and the amount of the scholarship to be granted, will be decided by a majority vote of the Professional Designation and Awards Committee.
